NOTIFICATION

S.O. whereas by the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Energy (Department of Coal) No. S.O. 1233 dated the 14th April, 1984 under sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 (20 of 1957), the Central Government gave notice of its intention to acquire the lands in the locality specified in the Schedule appended to that notification;

And whereas the Competent Authority, in pursuance of section 8 of the said Act, has made his report to the Central Government;

And whereas the Central Government, after considering the report aforesaid and after consulting the Government of Bihar, is satisfied that the lands measuring 521.50 acres (approximately) or 211.04 hectares (approximately) described in the Schedule appended hereto, should be acquired;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 9 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby declares that the lands measuring 521.50 acres (approximately) or 211.04 hectares (approximately), described in the said Schedule, are hereby acquired.

Boundary description:

A-B line passes through plot number 1437 in village Chapri, through plot number 137 in village Emlo, then through plot number 3020 in village Dhorhi (which forms part common boundary with Dhorhi Extra. block).

L-C-D lines pass through plot numbers 3020 and 3021 in village Dhorhi (which forms common boundary with Dhorhi (K) Extension block acquired under section 9(i) of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957)

- D-E-F lines pass through plot numbers 3021, 3058 and 3228 (River Damodar) in village Dhori (which forms part common boundary of Dhori Colliery).
- F-G lines passes along the part central line of Damodar River.
- G-H line passes through Damodar River and also along the part common boundary of villages Dhori and Makoli (which forms common boundary with new Selected Dhori Colliery).
- H-I line passes along the part common boundary of villages Dhori and Makoli and through plot number 1439 in village Chapri (which forms part common boundary of Gunjardih block acquired under section 9(1) of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition & Development) Act, 1957.)
- I-A line passes through plot numbers 1433, 943, 949, 950, 949, 951, 1439, 1438 and 1437 in village Chapri and meets at starting point 'A'.
