NOTIFICATION

S.O. 3706 WHEREAS by the notification of the government of India in the Ministry of Energy (Department of Coal) NO. S.O.3076 dated the 28th August, 1975, under sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 (20 of 1957), the Central Government gave notice of its intention to acquire the lands in the locality specified in the Schedule appended to that notification ;

AND WHEREAS the competent authority in pursuance of section 8 of the said Act has made his report to the Central Government;

AND WHEREAS the Central Government, after considering the report aforesaid, and, after consulting the Government of Bihar, is satisfied that the lands measuring 2525.23 acres (approximately) or 1021.96 hectares (approximately) described in the Schedule appended hereto should be acquired;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 9 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby declares that the lands measuring 2525.23 acres (approximately) or 1021.96 hectares (approximately) described in the said Schedule are hereby acquired.

2. The plans of the area covered by this notification may be inspected in the Office of the Deputy Commissioner, Hazaribagh (Bihar), the Deputy Commissioner, Giridih (Bihar), the Deputy Commissioner, Dhanbad (Bihar) or in the office of the Coal Controller, 1, Council House Street, Calcutta, or in the office of the Central Coalfields Limited (Revenue Section), Darbhanga House, Ranchi (Bihar).
