S.O. WHEREAS by the notification of the government of India in the Ministry of Energy (Department of Coal) NO. S.O.3076 dated the 28th August, 1975, under sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 (20 of 1957), the Central Government gave notice of 21s intention to acquire the lands in the locality specified in the Schedule appended to that notification;
