Whereas by the Notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Energy (Department of Coal), No. S.O. 3099 dated the 25th August, 1986, published in the Gazette of India part II, Section 3, Sub-Section (ii), dated the 13th September, 1986, issued under sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 (20 of 1957), the Central Government gave notice of its intention to acquire the land and rights in the locality specified in the Schedule annexed to that Notification;

And whereas the competent authority, in pursuance of section 8 of the said Act, has made his report to the Central Government;

And whereas the Central Government, after considering the report aforesaid, and after consulting the Government of Bihar, is satisfied that:-

- (a) the land measuring 216.75 acres (approximately) or 87.71 hectares (approximately) in block-I, 59.80 acres (approximately) or 24.20 hectares (approximately) in block-II, 13.85 acres (approximately) or 5.60 hectares (approximately) in block-III, 21.65 acres (approximately) or 8.76 hectares (approximately) in block-IV described in Schedule 'A' appended hereto; and
- (b) the rights to mine, quarry, bore, dig and search for, win, work and carry away minerals in the land measuring 11.35 acres (approximately) or 4.59 hectares (approximately) in block V, 31.60 acres (approximately) or 12.79 hectares (approximately) in block VI, described in schedule 'B' appended hereto.


